An option for students having anxiety, depression and/or social/emotional issues!

Also available to students suspended from school that are not violent

A psycho-educational approach to supportive services

Our program is for a unique alternative academic option for when:

- A student is having adjustment issues to a typical school setting
- A student needs assistance such as home instruction
- A student needing help with an electronic/On line school program
- A student is suspended from school for non violent reasons
- A student needs a short term/medium/longer term educational placement for support for social/emotional needs
- A student needs a partial day program

This new program offers a structured environment for students, grades 1-12. The classroom is supervised by an Ohio Licensed Special Education Teacher while the student completes the schoolwork from their own district or from their electronic school program.

Our goal is to have the student complete their own school work to receive credit for work done from their own school and to return ON ACADEMIC PAR! Students can stay in our program one day, one week, one month, one year, or as long as they need!

In addition, a student can be assessed by a licensed therapist and intensive or traditional psychological care can be provided. The therapist can also provide a complete psychological assessment and helpful intervention suggestions if needed. We are school district and parent friendly.
